Located at the northeast end of the University of Massachusetts Boston campus, the Edward M. Kennedy Institute for the United States Senate site simultaneously symbolizes the Kennedy family's important contribution to American politics and the late senator's commitment to the legislative process. A public center for civic education, the Institute sits just north of the Massachusetts State

Archives and is adjacent to the 1979 John F. Kennedy Presidential Library, designed by I. M. Pei. The Institute's design emphasizes a familial connection: consisting of a white square base topped with a smaller dark grey volume that houses a representation of the Senate Chamber, the building responds to the simple, intersecting geometric forms of the JFK Library.
